

**GENESEE COUNTY PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION
2011-12 WATERFOWL HUNTING LOCATION, RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The Genesee County Parks & Recreation Commission permits waterfowl hunting in certain Parks areas in conjunction with the waterfowl hunting season dates established by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources (DNR).

2011-12 Waterfowl Hunting Seasons

Geese:

October 8 – November 10, 2011 (Regular Season)
November 24 – December 4, 2011 (Regular Season)
December 31, 2011 – January 29, 2012 (Late Season)

Ducks (South Zone):

October 8 – December 4, 2011
December 10 – December 11, 2011

Permitted Locations for Waterfowl Hunting in the Genesee Recreation Area

Waterfowl hunting is permitted in the area of the Flint River behind the E.A. Cummings Center, east of Mott Lake, between the north/south boundary line across the water West of Belsay Rd. and to Vassar Rd. Hunting will be permitted on water surfaces only.

Rules

- All blinds must be portable (temporary anchorage only) and removed on a daily basis.
- All blinds and hunters must be at least 250 yards from any other blind and all other hunters.
- Permanent structures on land, riverbank or water bottomland are prohibited.
- Twelve (12) designated spots in the designated hunt area will be awarded to hunt groups each day of the season. A hunt group may consist of up to four (4) people.
- The twelve (12) hunt spots will be determined by a daily drawing held at the Genesee County Parks and Recreation Commission office at 5045 E. Stanley Rd., Flint, Michigan on the day prior for the following day hunt. The drawing will be held at 1:00 p.m.
- Entries must be submitted no later than 12:55 p.m. Only hunt groups drawn will be allowed in the hunt area for that day.
- Entries submitted must contain the names of all persons in the hunt group. No name may be duplicated or entered more than once during the day's drawing.
- Hunt groups must have in their possession the drawn hunt permit during the designated hunt day.

Fees in effect: \$6.00 per person; per day – Genesee County Resident

\$8.00 per person; per day – Non-Genesee County Resident

\$30.00 per person; per season – Genesee County Resident

\$40.00 per person; per season - Non-Genesee County Resident

A season pass does not guarantee a hunting spot, only if drawn.

All fees must be paid at the time of drawing, if you are drawn only. No entry fee.

All hunters must abide by all State and Federal hunting laws and regulations.
The Genesee County Parks and Recreation Commission may suspend waterfowl hunting in this area at any time and for any reason. These rules and regulations may be subject to change.
